Day 1 : July 10th 2017 - Pickup At Dublin Airport & Journey To Newcastle Northern Ireland



Welcome to Northern Ireland. You will be met at Dublin Airport by our luxury coach and swept off northwards up the East coast of Ireland to Newcastle in County Down, where the world famous Mountains of Mourne sweep down to the sea.



Our hotel for the duration of the trip is the Slieve Donard Hotel Resort and Spa in Newcastle, a luxury five star Victorian hotel, named Hotel of the Year 2016 and located right at the foot of the Mourne Mountains. On one side it is bounded by a golden beach and on the other by the world famous Royal County Down golf links.

Depending on your personal preference, you will have the choice of your own single room, or can share in a twin room. All rooms feature flat screen TV's and free Wi-Fi, slippers and bathrobes.

The hotel features several restaurants and bars. You can have breakfast, dinner and afternoon tea in the Oak Restaurant, plus Chaplin's Bar, the Lighthouse Lounge in the Spa and the Percy French Inn where you can relax over a pint and enjoy the 'craic' (and lunch as well if you wish).



Residents of the hotel have complimentary access to the hotel's pool, and can avail of the extensive Spa facilities spread over two floors, with fabulous views over the sea and mountains, including a 20 metre pool.

And, of course, you don't have to be tied down to the hotel, as Newcastle features a wide range of restaurants and bars, all within close proximity to the hotel.

Newcastle is very close to a range of areas of great natural beauty, including Tollymore Forest Park, Castlewellan Forest Park (which features the Peace Maze, world's largest permanent hedge maze), the ruins of Maghera Round Tower, Dundrum Castle and the Silent Valley, an area of parkland built around a reservoir built within the Mourne Mountains.

The scenic Ring of Gullion route is adjacent to the Mournes, and further afield we have Belfast, Antrim, and the fabulous Causeway Coast, leading to the Giants Causeway, so there is no shortage of areas of great beauty that will take your breath away.

Days 2 to 7 : July 11th 2016 – July 16th

Each morning you will be collected from your hotel and brought by luxury coach to a hand picked area of particular artistic interest, where you will have the opportunity to capture the essence of the sights you will see in your chosen artistic medium.

Following your outing each day, the coach will return you to your hotel, where you will have the opportunity to relax, enjoy the facilities of the hotel, have a meal, enjoy a pint of Guinness or, if you prefer, explore the night-life that Newcastle has to offer.
